


Figure 4 - Confirm the password

Or just click on the explore button place on the top header. Then it will be redirect to course catalogue page.




Figure 6 - Explore button

When course category page loaded, user will be able to view the course description by moving the mouse over the course as shown below.




Figure 7 - Course catalogue

Then click on more information thereafter system will redirected to below figure where user can enroll for a course without the administrator.




Figure 8 - Course enrolment

After the enrollment when user clicks on a course it will show the course information.




Figure 9 - Course page information

User can use the controls in the course player to navigate through the course. And user can navigate through the course modules with the help of lesson panel and other navigation tools which highlighted on below screen.




Figure 11 - Course navigation




Figure 12 - View my courses

Then it will be redirected to this screen, where user needs to enter the user name.




Figure 14 - Forgot password
